Niagara Aerospace Museum to Host Historic WWII Bombers at Niagara Falls Airport

SUMMARY:

The Niagara Aerospace Museum is hosting the Commemorative Air Force's Airpower History Tour, including the famous B-29 and B-24 four-engine bombers and the P-51 Mustang. The five-day event is September 1-5, 2022, at the Niagara Aerospace Museum located at the Niagara Falls International Airport, 9990 Porter Road, Niagara Falls, NY 14304. Visitors can tour the aircraft on the airport ramp or view them from inside the museum all five days. Rides on the aircraft are also available. Through the generous help of the Niagara Frontier Transit Authority (NFTA) and Calspan Air Services, the Niagara Aerospace Museum is pleased to announce the Commemorative Air Force's Airpower History Tour visit to Western New York.

The Commemorative Air Force

preserves vintage, flying US combat aircraft. Their Airpower History Tour helps the current generation understand the spirit in which these aircraft were flown in defense of our nation.

There are only two B-29 and two B-24 bombers still flying in the world today. This a unique opportunity to see these amazing and rare aircraft up close. On Saturday through Monday (September 3 – 5), the CAF is offering limited seats for paying passengers to ride on the airplanes. Visitors will be able to walk up to the aircraft and tour inside the cockpits. Visitors will also be able to tour the Niagara Aerospace Museum during their visit. The cost for accessing the aircraft on the ramp is \$20 for adults, \$10 for ages 11 – 17, free for under age 11. Visitors who wish to only visit the museum and not go outside to see the aircraft may do so at the normal museum price of \$10 for adults, \$5 for Seniors/Military/Ages 5-20, and free for Members/Under 5/ADA caregiver.

The address is 9990 Porter Road, Niagara Falls, NY 14304. Parking is free in the lot in front of the museum for this event.
